## Legionella Training - Responsible Persons and Duty Holders

### Description

The course provides those in control of premises or water systems training as to the nature of Legionnaires' disease, its history, and the current compliance requirements as outlined in the HSE ACoP L8 and HSG274 technical guidance documents. It will provide you with essential information on the processes and procedures required to help with the successful management and control of Legionella in water systems. It is expected that the candidates will have some background knowledge in Legionella management and control.

### Training aim

To provide trainees with the knowledge and skills required to help them manage the risk from Legionella in their workplace.

### Who would benefit?

Staff whose responsibilities include the management of building services, water systems that require an understanding of their responsibilities and legal requirements in relation to Legionella management and control.

### Training coverage:

- History & case studies
- Legislation and guidance
- The responsible person – legal requirements, roles and responsibilities
- The bacteria and disease
- Risk assessments
- Managing the risk - written scheme, control measures, monitoring, auditing and record keeping
- Biological monitoring

The course can be customised depending upon delegate requirements

### Course duration

The course is run over 1 day and is assessed through a short test at the end

## Legionella Training - General Awareness

### Description

The course provides a basic introduction to Legionella Management and Control. It will help the trainee understand the legal requirements so they are aware of their responsibilities in relation to Legionella control in water systems. It will cover the technical requirements involved in control measures to ensure systems are maintained safely helping to minimise bacterial growth.

### Training purpose

To provide candidates with awareness of current legal and technical requirements for the control of Legionella in water systems. It will help the trainees understand the skills required to carry out effective management and maintenance of systems in accordance with current guidance and legislation.

### Who would benefit?

The course is aimed at those who are involved in the management and maintenance of water systems, including maintenance staff and supervisors.

### Training coverage:

- History
- The bacteria and disease
- Legal aspects
- Control measures – minimising the risk from cooling towers (if applicable), domestic water systems and other systems
- Record keeping
- Practical advice on carrying out inspection and monitoring – practical training can be given if requested

The course may be customised depending upon delegate requirements.

### Course length

The course is run over 1/2 day and is assessed through a short test at the end.

### Course location

At your site or an ESG regional office.

### Training certification

This course is CIBSE approved and counts towards CPD hours. CIBSE certificates are provided upon the successful completion of the course.



## Legionella Training - Usage Evaluation and Flushing

### Description

A successful usage evaluation and flushing programme can be one of the hardest control measures to implement and manage successfully, especially at large multi building sites such as hospitals and universities. Its success relies on the end user understanding what they have to do and why they have to do it. Our usage evaluation and flushing training course is a short but detailed introduction to Legionella management and the importance of usage evaluation and flushing.

### Training purpose

The aim is to provide the end user and those responsible for flushing an appreciation of Legionella management and control and the importance of their role and responsibilities.

### Who would benefit?

Water services end users and their managers.

### Training coverage:

- An introduction to Legionella, Legionnaires Disease and its Management and Control
- Practical advice on carrying out usage evaluation and flushing
- Record Keeping

The course may be customised depending upon delegate requirements.

1 - 2 hours – we can run up to 4 sessions per day
