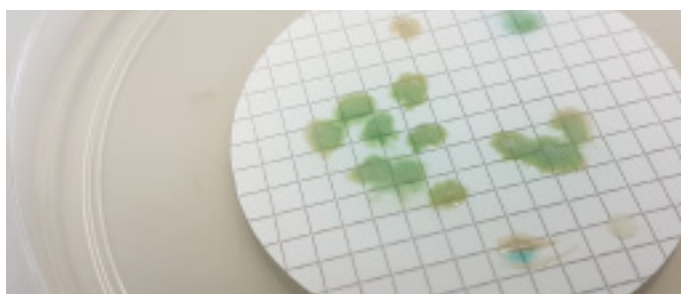
Pseudomonas aeruginosa in augmented care seminar
